Short Learning Programme Course Outline: Delegation of Powers in Local Government Training duration - 8 contact hours

Purpose of short learning programme (SLP)

This 1-day short learning programme offers councillors a brief overview of the requirements for valid and lawful delegation and its operation in the municipal environment and explains the principle of legality with regard to the exercise of public power in order to ensure that municipalities comply with the law.
