Short Learning Programme Outline: Principles of Advanced Law Enforcement for Professional Municipal Staff

24 contact hours (3 days)

Purpose of Short Learning Programme (SLP)

The main purpose of this SLP is:

- To provide theoretical knowledge required for professional staff of municipalities such as Town Planners, Building Control Officers, Fire Chiefs and Environmental Managers
- To ensure compliance with the National, Provincial and Municipal legislation applicable to their functions as well as the implementation of administrative, civil and criminal enforcement measures available.

Entrance Requirements

An NQF level 5 qualification is necessary and at least 3 years working experience in local government. Applicants will be required to go through a selection process.

Assessment Practice

- Assessment of students comprises a written knowledge test and a written practical
 assessment which requires the identification of empowering provisions, offences and
 enforcement measures in terms of relevant legislation and the completion of applicable
 notices and statements in terms of given scenarios.
- Students must obtain 50% pass rate for the theory part and 70% pass rate for the practical part in order to comply with the assessment requirements of the SLP.

Kindly note students are required to attend all training days for the duration of the course.
